

Application for admission to Associate Fellow

To be eligible for admission for the distinction of Associate Fellow, an Associate or Library Technician member must:

- a. be a current financial Associate or Library Technician member of the Association;
- b. have been an Associate member or Library Technician member of the Association for at least five years;
- c. be currently participating in the Association's Professional Development scheme and can demonstrate ongoing compliance for a minimum of five years. An Associate Fellow is required to maintain compliance in the Professional Development scheme;
- d. be able to demonstrate professional/technical and personal knowledge and skills;
- e. provide evidence of a significant degree of autonomy in decision-making in practice;
- f. be currently employed in the Australian library and information sector or an allied sector.

The distinction of Associate Fellow may be conferred upon those Associate members and Library Technician members who demonstrate that they meet criteria (a)-(f) of this clause and who have been members of the Association's professional development scheme and have maintained compliance with the scheme for a period of at least five years and who continue to maintain compliance with the scheme.

Associate members with library and information studies qualifications admitted to the distinction of Associate Fellowship of the Association may use the post nominal AFALIA(CP).

Associate members with qualifications in an allied field admitted to the distinction of Associate Fellowship of the Association may use the post nominal AFALIA qualified with such indicators as shall be approved from time to time by the Board of Directors.

Library technician members admitted to the distinction of Associate Fellowship of the Association may use the post nominal AFALIATec (CP).
