1. You grant ALIA a non-exclusive licence to publish, communicate, reproduce, adapt, modify and use the material for any purpose and in any format or medium. The licence includes a right of sub-licence. For avoidance of doubt, ALIA may collect fees or other returns in exercise of this licence.

(This means that ALIA may publish your article in various formats or media, license it to third parties such as database aggregators, and collect any fees earned by such uses.
