### What we're doing

We want to help you stay safe in the library. We regularly clean surfaces that people touch, such as tables, door handles and computer keyboards.



### Stay 1.5 metres apart

COVID-19 is most likely to spread by being near to a person while they are infectious or from touching objects or surfaces that they have coughed or sneezed on, and then touching your mouth or face. The more space you create between you and other people, the harder it is for the virus to spread.



### Keep other people safe



Stay at home if you don't feel well



Try not to touch other people



Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly



Cough or sneeze into your elbow – not your hands
